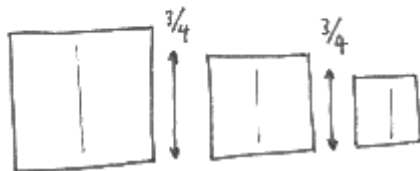


SIMPLE ROSE

① THREE SHEETS OF RED PAPER

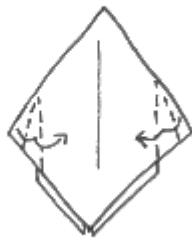


② FOLD ALL INTO PRELIMINARY BASES



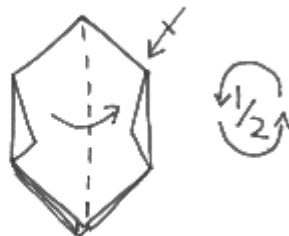
FOLD TOP LAYER AS SHOWN. TURN OVER.

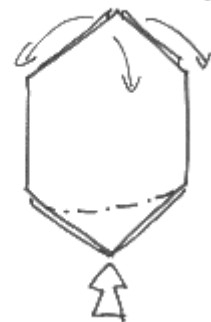
REPEAT STEP 2

FOLD ONE FLAP TO THE RIGHT & FOLD ONE FLAP TO THE LEFT BEHIND. ROTATE

VERY LOOSELY SINK THE BOTTOM OF THE MODEL. OPEN OUT THE TOP

⑥ ASSEMBLE ALL THREE UNITS. FIT THEM INSIDE EACH OTHER, ROTATING SLIGHTLY



⑦ LIKE SO



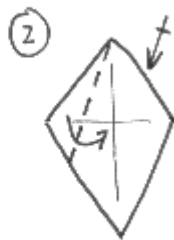
THE THICKER THE PAPER, THE BETTER. IF THE MODEL DOES NOT HOLD TOGETHER WELL, USE 3 OR 4 VALLEY FOLDS IN STEP 2, RATHER THAN JUST TWO.

ROSE BASE

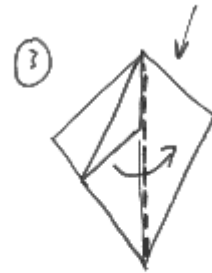
① USE A GREEN SHEET OF PAPER THE SAME SIZE AS THE LARGEST RED SHEET IN 'SIMPLE ROSE'. BIRD BASE



REPEAT BEHIND



FOLD ONE LAYER TO CENTRE. REPEAT BEHIND (ON OPPOSITE SIDE)



SWING ONE LAYER OVER. REPEAT BEHIND

REPEAT STEP 2 ON NEXT TWO FLAPS

FOLD TO TOP

REVERSE FOLD (i.e. REPEAT STEP 5 ON NEXT FLAPS)

OPEN MODEL OUT

LIKE SO. THE SIMPEE ROSE MODEL CAN BE PLACED SO THAT THE ROUND PART SITS IN THE CENTRAL HOLE. SOME GLUE WILL HOLD IT IN PLACE
