


Formation of tail






Reverse fold part way to form golden end of tail




Mountain fold

Two crimp folds, one to shape shoulders, one to form head.



At this point, the Tatsu can be left as a finished model. However, the head can be finished further. View model as shown.








Panels labled to make next steps clear

Repeat steps 21-23 on the right side of the model




From inside model, head mostly unfolded. Push finger where arrow is...








Pinch folds to form face
